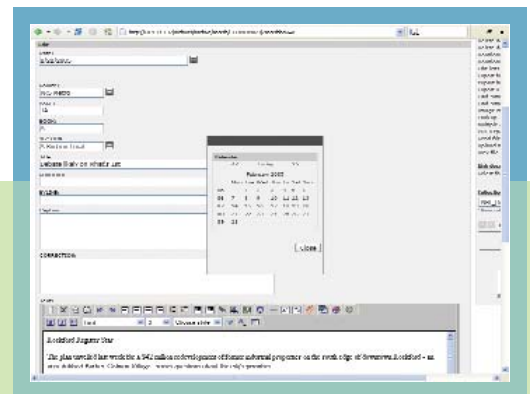

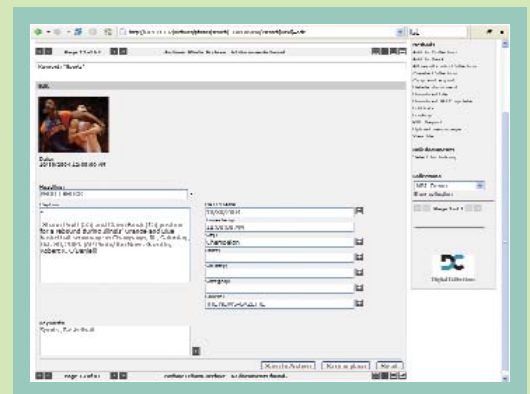
The interMedia® search engine offers the ease of use that today's users demand, while also supporting the complex needs of librarians and research professionals. And since both the database and the search engine are Oracle

As publishers expand their requirements for managing multiple file types, Digital Collections expands its capabilities to meet those requirements. DC5 stores a wide variety of data types including text (NewsML, NITE, XML, HTML, ASCII), photos, graphics, PDF files (e.g., pages, documents, digital tearsheets), audio, video and native file formats.



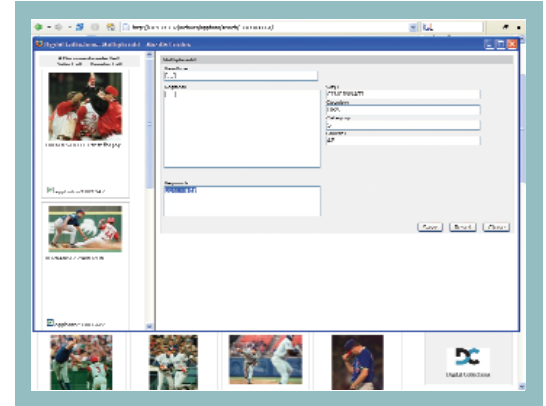
The tags editing capabilities built into the DC5 client are designed to optimize productivity for data hygiene tasks performed by an archivist. Drop-down menus contain lists for common tags such as Keyword, Source, Section, Byline, Category, City, State and others. Privileged users can easily add, modify and delete entries in the tags lists using the Lists Editor. An interactive pop-up calendar functions as a date picker (above and below).



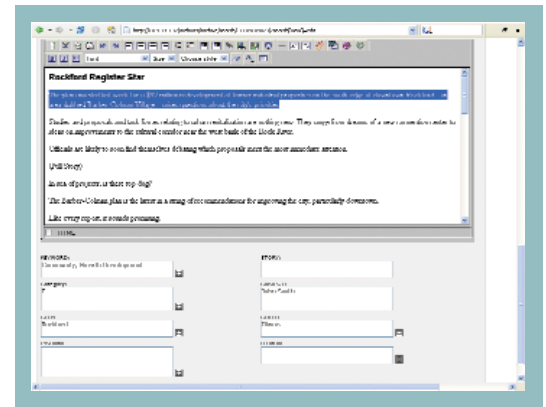
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## Take a look at some of the often-requested features that are built into the DC5 System:

- The automated generation of taxonomies instantly gives users a 15,000 foot view of the database and a choice of places to go to find what they are looking for. It instantly brings to view the shortest distance between two points: the user and the information he/she desires.
- A word processor-like HTML editor provides archivists with a powerful set of content editing tools for quickly and easily annotating and correcting text documents. It even includes a spelling checker and feature for formatting and editing tabular data.
- Real Simple Syndication (RSS) channel feeds can be plugged directly into the DC5 Web browser client – to facilitate global research and the monitoring of breaking news.
- The DC5 “Crop and Export” tool facilitates high-speed processing of local and wire photos for print and online publishing. Use of the Crop-and-Export tool is accommodated through site-specific configuration of photo workflow paths for importing and exporting photos.
- Workflow queues called “Desks” are provided to automate orderly point-to-point workflow for importing and exporting documents, and within the system for approval and review processes.
- Advanced search features include “Find Similar Images” which spawns a search based on image content (to find more images like the one a user has selected), and “Find Similar Documents” which spawns a search based on the content of a selected document. Simple and Advanced search templates are also provided.
- The ability to link multiple documents of diverse file types – manually and/or automatically, is provided. For example, a PDF page and the image and text files that it contains can all be linked for simultaneous retrieval.
- The Collections feature allows users to create their own private or public catalogs of documents for special use. Collections can be created, modified and deleted at will without impacting available database storage capacity.
- Document version management and retention is provided in DC5.



The DC5 Batch Editor allows privileged users to edit multiple documents in a single editing transaction. For example, one may add a keyword, change a byline, and delete or change an incorrect tag for any number of selected documents with a single edit—saving countless hours of tedious work.



DC5 includes a word processor-like editor with a comprehensive set of tools to quickly and easily make edits, annotations and corrections to text documents. It includes a spelling checker as well as a feature for formatting and editing tabular data.
